SALVATION

Romans 5:8 (ESV), "God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

Revelation 7:9 (NIV), "After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands."

- * Pray for healing and forgiveness to happen between the "nations" living in our community.
- * Pray that each believer would have the heart of God for their neighbors.



TRANSFORMATION

Isaiah 43:19 (ESV), "Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert."
